Teachers Feedback:-

Feedback is a valuable tool for teachers to improve their teaching methods and create a more effective learning environment for students.

- Provide feedback on classroom management: Provide feedback on the teacher's classroom management skills and how they create a positive learning environment.

- Provide feedback on assessment methods: Provide feedback on the teacher's use of formative assessments and how they diversify their assessment methods.
